

Please follow up important verbal instructions by writing them clearly on the board in dark pen.




It is hard for me to see when I face direct light. It is hard for me to see you if you are standing in front of a window.

Any DVD's I watch need to have subtitles. I <u>really</u> need them.




Hand gestures can help reinforce what you are verbally communicating.

When the class is noisy I find it really hard to hear the teacher.




Slow down and speak clearly when talking please.
